Bus Timetable Changes.

From **21st May** East Yorkshire (EYMS) and Transdev/Coastliner are making some changes to their Dunnington buses.



- **First York** service 10 is unchanged.
- The **Transdev/Coastliner** changes are minor and just see adjustments of a minute or two (though sometimes earlier than before, so don't miss it!)
- **EYMS** changes are more substantial and see the cancellation of their Sunday services through the village. However, they are introducing a Monday to Saturday 9.15pm bus from Piccadilly to Dunnington which fills a current long gap. Note also though that their late bus at 11.15pm from Piccadilly will now be Friday and Saturday only.
