Marble maze

You will need:

An old shoe box lid or a paper plate

Coloured paper

Straws

Glue

marble



1. Line the shoe box lid with coloured paper (this step is optional)
2. Cut a marble sized hole in the two opposing ends of the box and in opposite corners.
3. With a pencil draw out a path of where you would like the straws to go to create your maze. Make it as tricky as you want.
4. Cut out lengths of straw and glue to the paper/lid to create the maze shape.
5. There you have you own marble maze run.
