Listening Ears Craft

You will need:

- Card
- Glue
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Colouring pencils or felt pens



1. Using a piece of card (approx. 8cms wide) make a band which fits around your child's head. Secure both ends of band with sticky tape.
2. Cut out two large ear shapes, two eyes and a trunk shape.
3. Colour in eyes, trunk and ears, then attach to side of the band with glue or sticky tape.
4. Add 'My Listening Ears' (if wanted) to front of band.
5. You're ready to go!
