

Magic foaming snowman

You will need Bicarbonate of soda Washing up liquid Salt

Vinegar

Decorations



- 1. In a bowl mix 2 cups of bicarbonate of soda and 2 tablespoons of salt.
- 2. Mix thoroughly, then add 1 teaspoon of washing up liquid.
- 3. Next add 8 tablespoons of water and form the dough into a ball. If it is too crumbly, add 1 tablespoon of water at a time until it forms a dough.
