Plant thefts in the village of Dunnington.

Overnight, at Cherry Tree Court, on Dec 26th 2022 someone stole a Lemon Scented Monterey Cypress Goldcrest plants (these are the light green coloured plants which look like small fir trees). And last night on Jan 6/7th, they stole a second one. Both plants were around 3ft tall in round light grey pots. The size of the plants suggests the thief may have used a vehicle to steal them, as I doubt anyone would have walked off down the high-street with them.

I've informed the police about the thefts and kindly ask if residents can keep any eye out for suspicious activity at night, especially in the Cherry Tree Court area, which is near the shops.
