

### **Benefice News And Events**

#### St Nicholas Church air quality monitoring

We are very grateful that Steve Wilson is able to bring a carbon dioxide monitor along to church occasionally so that we can monitor levels of this during our services. It looks a bit like a smart meter and if the levels go above a certain level, this indicates that we need to improve ventilation (by opening a door or two). Many schools and offices are now using these monitors to help protect against airborne infections. As the winter infections start to rise we need to try and ensure our building is as safe a place to gather for worship as possible.

A bonus feature is that the monitor can give a reading of the air temperature. We found on Sunday that it quickly rises once the service starts. This will help us by ensuring that we don't waste a lot of money heating the church to more than a reasonable 16.5 C before services start. (On Sunday the temperature rose to 18 C by the end of the service.)

#### St Nicholas Church cleaning

I am about to draw up a new rota for church cleaning for next year (just the church - the Tower Room has a separate team!) if you would like to go on the rota - it only gets done once a month and you can decide when to come in to do it. A pair of volunteers is allocated a month - the more volunteers we have the less often your turn comes round. At present there are 4 'teams' so it would be less than 3 times a year if we get more volunteers.

I am intending to hold an Advent pre-Christmas cleaning session in December which will include getting all the brasses clean ready for our Christmas celebrations. More details on this nearer the time! Thank you. Carole.
