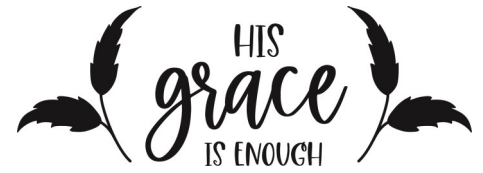

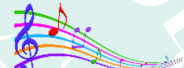
Beer 'n' Hymns 'n' Pimms
