Heart paper chains

You will need: Coloured paper Scissors

Glue



- Cut our several hearts the same size from the coloured paper.

- 3. Open out the hearts and make a cut at the side of each heart.
- 4. Link the hearts together by overlapping the cut edges and gluing them.
- 5. Children could write names of people on the hearts who they would like to know God's love.
