Strengthen us,

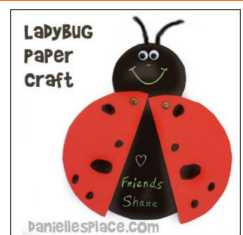

Ladybird Friends Craft

You will need

Black & Red Card
Googly eyes
Metal paper fasteners
Pipe cleaners
Scissors
Hole punch
Felt tips



1. Cut a large circle out of the black card for the ladybird's body, a large red circle for the wings and a small black circle for the head.
2. Glue the head onto the body.
3. Cut the large red circle in half for the wings.
4. Line up the wings with the body so that it is completely covered. Punch a hole through the wings and the body and attach the wings with paper fasteners. If the paper fasteners are sharp seal the ends with a piece of sticky tape.
5. Cut a pipe cleaner about 6 inches long and fold in half for the antennae. Glue to the back of the ladybird's head.
6. Decorate the wings with spots and glue on googly eyes.
