### Sunflower Paper Loop Craft

You will need:

Yellow & green paper

Coloured paper as a base for the sunflower

Glue

Scissors

Sunflower seeds



1. Cut a strip of green paper for a stem and stick it on the base.
2. Cut a yellow circle and two leaf shapes out of green paper.
3. Pinch the leaf shapes to give them volume.
4. Stick the yellow circle and the leaves onto the stem.
5. Cut out some strips from the yellow paper, about a finger width wide and 21cms long and then cut each strip in half.
6. Fold the strips in half and glue the ends together to make a loop.
7. Stick the paper loops around the circle to make your sunflower.
8. Cover the circle in glue and stick on sunflower seeds.
