St Patrick's Day craft

You will need:

Paper plate, Paints, Cotton wool, Wool, Green paper, glue



1. Cut the paper plate in half.
2. Paint rainbow arches on the half plate.
3. Cut out the centre of the arch that did not get painted.
4. Cut 4 pieces of wool in varying lengths and attach to the back of the plate.
5. Cut out some clover shapes from the green paper.
6. Glue the clovers onto the wool, using 2 at a time and sandwiching the wool between them.
7. Add cotton wool at each end of the rainbow, for clouds.
