Heart craft



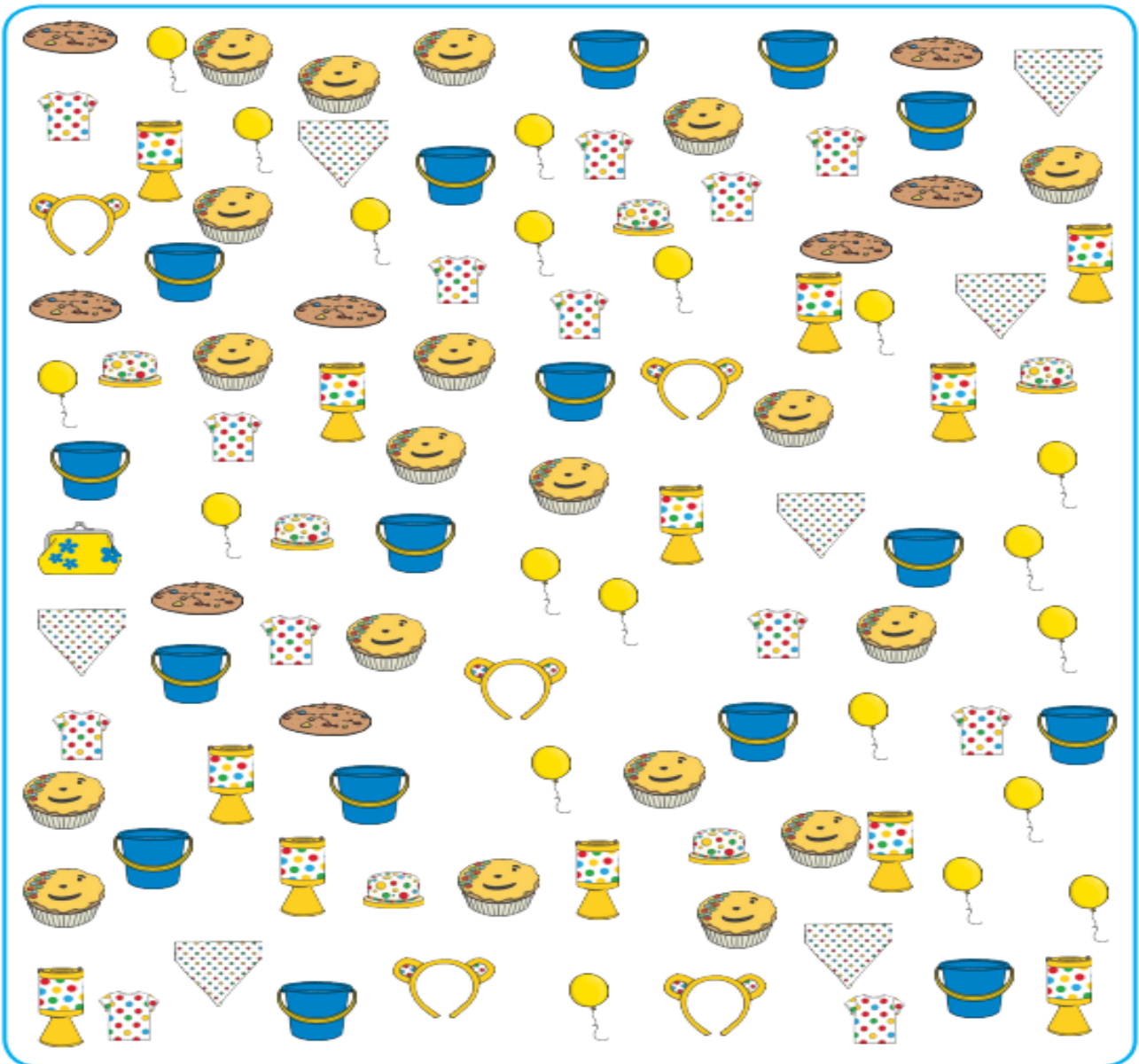
You will need

- Coloured paper
- Glue
- Sequins
- Scissors

1. Cut out two hearts from the paper. One large and the other smaller.
2. Glue the smaller heart on top of the larger heart.
3. Write the words 'Jesus Loves Me' on the smaller heart or alternatively, if you would prefer, write your child's name.
4. Decorate around the smaller heart with sequins or glitter.
5. If you want to hang your heart up, make a hole in the top and thread through some ribbon.
