Bee Craft

You will need:

Egg box
Yellow paint
Black wool
Googly eyes
White paper
Glue



1. Cut your egg box into sections. You'll need one section per bee.
2. Paint your egg section with yellow paint.
3. Once dry, make a small cut in the bottom front edge of your carton. Put a piece of black wool in the slit you have made.
4. Wrap the wool around the bee body and then make another small slit on the opposite back end of the bee body. Slip the end of the wool into the slit to hold in place.
5. Glue on googly eyes and add a smile using a black marker pen.
6. Cut some wings out of the white paper and glue on top of your bee.
