Black paper

Table salt

Glue

Watercolour Paints & Paintbrush




- Draw your picture on the black paper using the white glue.
   If you don't want to make a cross you can decide on your design but keep to simple outlines as it works better.
- 2. Next sprinkle salt all over the glue.
- 3. Pour off the excess salt. You don't need to leave it to dry before painting.
- 4. Start painting with your watercolour paint gently on top of the salt and watch what happens to the colours.
