Cross

You will need

- White paper
- Card
- Paint or crayons



1. Cut a cross shape out of the card and place on the white paper.
2. Hold the card in place and paint or crayon on the paper around the cross shape. (It doesn't matter here if you colour and paint on the cross as this will be removed.)
3. Once you have filled the white paper with colour, remove the cross template and this should leave the outline of your cross in the middle of your paper surrounded by colour.
