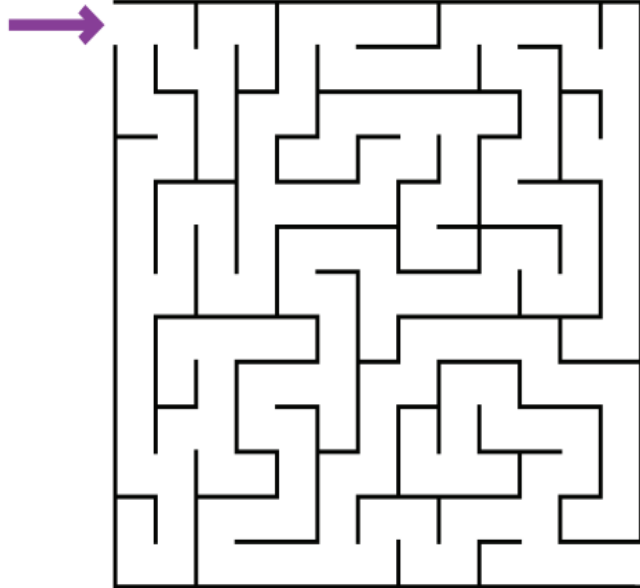

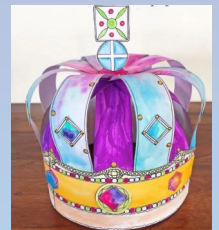

- Felt pens
- Stick on jewels or sequins
- Glue/sticky tape

Dear God,

As we celebrate the Platinum Jubilee, we thank you for all the good things Queen Elizabeth has done for our country. Help us be strong to work for further change, so that together we make the world a better place for all.

Amen.

1. Cut a strip of card (approximately 8cms wide) that will fit around your child's head to form the base of the crown and stick the ends together with tape.
2. Next cut out 4 strips of card (approximately 3cms wide) to form the top of the crown.
3. Tape a strip of card inside the base of the crown and creating a loop tape the other end to the opposite side of the base. Repeat with the other 3 strips of card.
4. You can add a cardboard jewel to the top of the crown if you wish.
5. Decorate using felt pens, jewels and sequins.

The Platinum Jubilee marks **70 years** of a monarch's reign. Queen Elizabeth II is the first British monarch to reach this milestone!
