## Origami fish

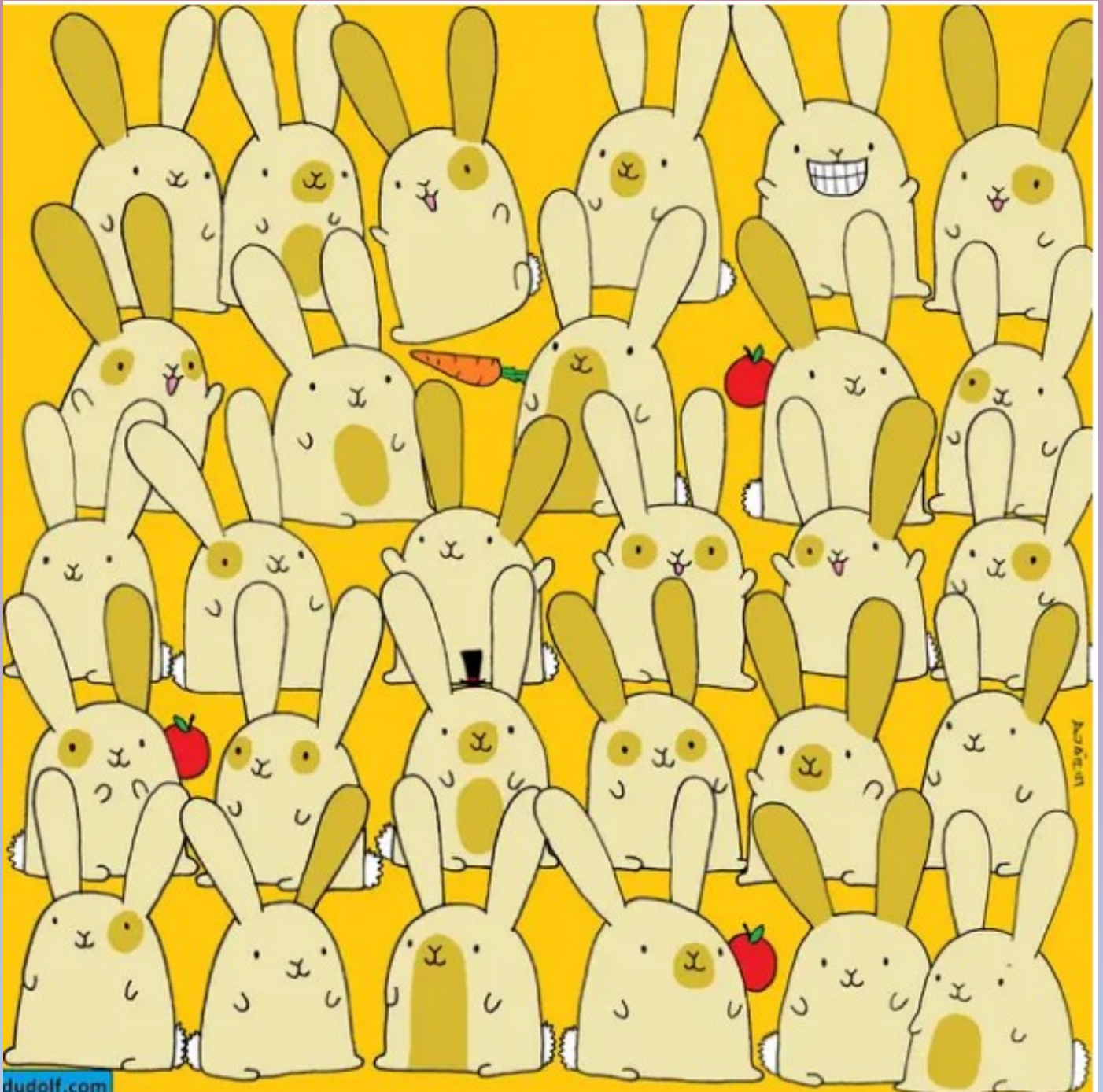
### You will need:

Squares of coloured paper  
Googly eyes (optional)



1. Start by folding a square piece of paper diagonally (both sides) and in half (one side) – crease and unfold.
2. Hold the paper as indicated with blue spots and fold towards the centre to get a triangle shape.
3. Now hold the right bottom corner of the triangle and fold it toward the centre along the crease.
4. Do the same with the other corner to create the fish's tail.
