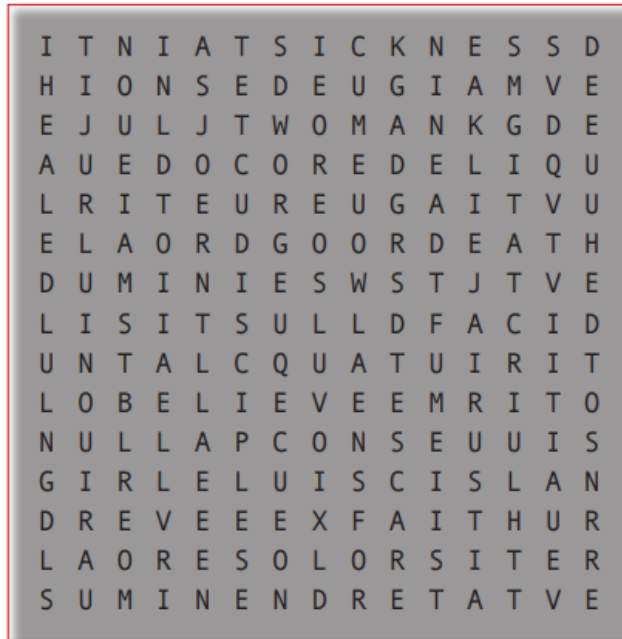

Fireworks in a glass



You will need:

Warm water

Oil (vegetable or olive)

Food colouring

1. Fill a glass 3/4 of the way to the top with warm water.
2. In a separate glass add a few tablespoons of oil and add 4 drops of food colouring - of differing colours.
3. Using a fork, give the oil and food colouring mixture a good mix to break up the 'colour beads' into smaller ones.
4. Carefully pour the oil & food colouring mixture into the glass of warm water and watch what happens!
