3d paper caterpillar

You will need:

Green and red paper Glue Scissors Black marker pen



- Using an A4 size of green paper, draw a line about 1/3 from the edge of the paper lengthways.
- 2. Cut strips 2cm wide from the opposite side of the paper to the drawn line.
- 3. Fold along the line.
- 4. Glue each cut strip to the top of the paper to make a loop.
- 5. Cut two head shapes out of the red paper and antennae out of green paper and attach one head to each side of the looped shape and glue them together at the top. Add eyes and a mouth with black marker pen.
- 6. Your wiggly caterpillar is now ready!
