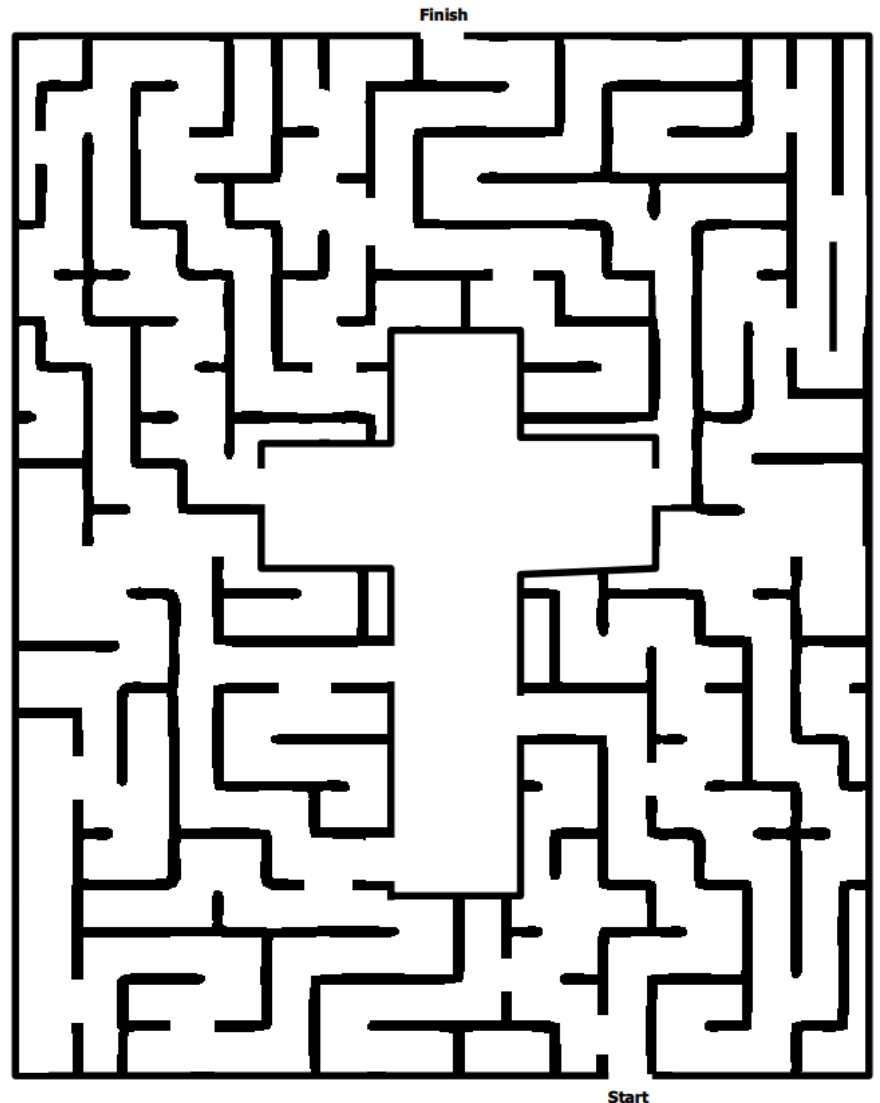
## Joke Book

Dear God

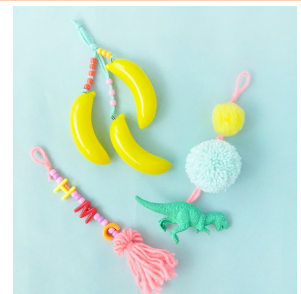
Use my eyes to see new friends,

## Back pack tags

### You will need

Small plastic toys  
 Beads  
 Scissors & thread  
 Nail or safety pin



1. If using small plastic toys they need to be thin plastic and hollow. Make a hole in the top and bottom of the plastic toy.
2. Make a long loop from the yarn and thread the yarn through the plastic toy securing with a knot at the bottom.
3. Add beads in whatever pattern you want or include your initials using letter beads.
4. If you want to add a tassel to the end, make it from several pieces of folded yarn then tie another piece of yarn around the top about 1cm from the end to secure.
5. Customise your tag however you would like.
