at St Nicholas Church.

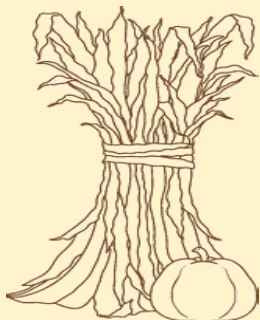
We will remember our loved ones who are no longer
