Christian Aid Donations. We have had our first count and have sent £1,320.03 (with £762 gift aided) from Dunnington and £272 (with £200 gift aided) from Warthill. If you still have your envelope please return it to Church by 1st July when we will do the final count.

Giving. Every year St Nicholas' Church donates 10% of the money received via the collection plate and standing orders to worthy causes, usually one UK charity and one overseas. This year the PCC have chosen ShelterBox and YoYo (York Schools and Youth Trust). Each charity will receive £3,900.
