Today is Marathon Sunday and access to some of our villages, and to York, will be limited.

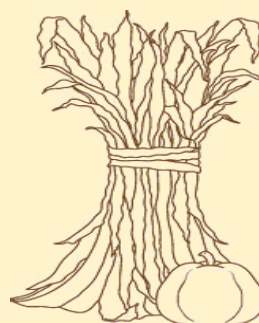
There will be a 10.30 Contemporary Communion Service in Dunnington and Morning Worship in Stockton.
