

# Reflection for Trinity Sunday by Revd Dr John Schofield



Sunday 12th June this year is Trinity Sunday. I was warned, while in training for the ordained ministry, that if you attempt to preach about the Trinity (the One God, as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) you would inevitably preach some form of heresy. For that kind of reason many leading worship on this Sunday will avoid the subject, or mention it in passing.

Having warned you of this, I would suggest, never-the-less, we should appreciate the complexity and mystery of the Godhead being three, and yet one. If we overemphasise one aspect of the Trinity then we get God wrong. Yes, Jesus the Son is important, but so too is the Father (whom we see in Jesus) and so too is God the Holy Spirit.

While for many Christians one person of the Trinity is most helpful to them. For others one can be problematic. For instance, family relationships can be problematic, and seeing God as Father can be difficult because of that, or even as Son.

And then how is God the 'Holy Ghost'? Wherever we find ourselves in this, we should (despite the difficulties) see how God is Father, Son and Holy Spirit: for that is so valuable for us.
